The program is an exciting and challenging one designed to train selected REALTOR® and Affiliate members of the Board, equipping them to serve as directors, officers, and committee chairs. Candidates completing the course will be qualified for future leadership of our Board and will be awarded the Certified Leadership Graduate (CLG) designation.

Whether you realize it or not, all of us are in leadership positions and have the same opportunity to influence and encourage others. Why not become the best you can be this year? Whether your aspirations are directed toward leading a committee, strengthening your personal goals, becoming more involved in a TBR leadership position, or becoming a better leader in community boards and organizations, we encourage you to apply.

# **Eligibility**

- A. Tallahassee Board of REALTORS® member for at least one year as of application deadline date (December 21, 2022).
- B. Must have served on at least one committee of the Tallahassee Board of REALTORS®, or will serve in 2023.
- C. Must be an RPAC contributor for 2023, prior to the start of the program.

## Requirements

- A. Applicants must fully complete the Leadership Academy application (pages 6 and 7 of this packet) and return it by **December 21, 2022 to Susan@TBRnet.org**. *Please type your application*.
- B. Required tuition is \$300 per participant, due at the time of application (will be refunded if not accepted into the program).
- C. Submit accountability sheets as required to confirm meeting attendance.
- D. Participants are required to attend the **REQUIRED MEETINGS AND EVENTS** listed on pages 4 and 5, below.

#### E. Attendance

- 1. Attendance is required at all meetings. Absences for unforeseen circumstances will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis by the Leadership Academy Deans.
- 2. If a participant misses the Florida REALTORS® conference in August, he or she will not graduate. Participant will not be reimbursed for any expenses incurred if participant fails to attend.

Selection will be made by a panel of Tallahassee Board of REALTORS® Past Presidents.
